You can tear off a \$1, \$3, or \$5 (or multiples of these) to make a contribution to local environmental and conservation charities which are members of EarthShare of Texas. The great thing is that **100%** of your donations will support local member groups.

EarthShare of Texas has 40 member organizations like ours, all over the state of Texas. So, if you are traveling and have to get groceries in another town, even contributing \$1 is helpful and supports local organizations.
